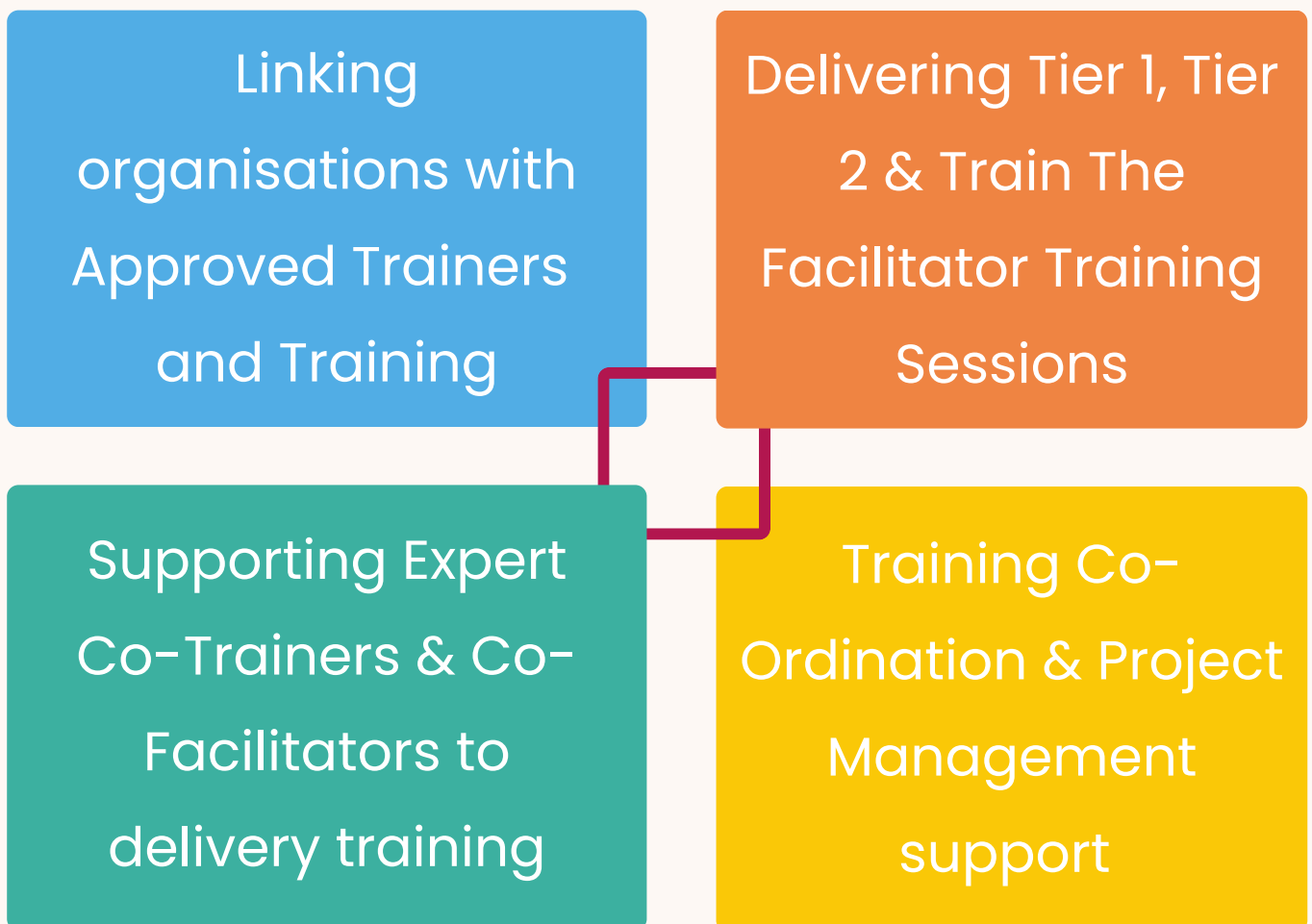

Tier 2 is for professionals in direct patient facing roles – social care staff, nurses, care assistants and anyone who provides direct care and support to individuals with learning disability and autism.

The training emphasises the importance of informed, empathetic interaction and equips staff with key knowledge and understanding for delivering personalised care.

You will gain a deeper understanding of the unique challenges and strengths autistic people and people with a learning disability face, leading to more effective and compassionate care delivery.

Each part of the Oliver's Training needs to be delivered in partnership with co-trainers with lived experience. To deliver the one-day Tier 2 training, organisations will need a training team of Facilitating Trainers with specialist learning disability and autism experience, and teams of Co-Trainers with a learning disability and Co-Trainers who are autistic.

Tier 2 Co-Trainer Training

(Experts with lived experience of Learning Disabilities and/or Autism)

3 x full day face to face training

£1,125 per person
